Course Description

This intensive two day course is designed for registered nurses who plan to take the Certified Rehabilitation Registered Nurse Examination or as a refresher course for current CRRN's. Participants will be provided a broad overview of rehabilitation nursing standards of care and practice based upon the Rehabilitation Nursing Core Curriculum with tools and test taking strategies to successfully pass the CRRN exam.

Target Audience:

Registered Nurses who work in Rehabilitation, Sub-Acute, SNF, and Home Health settings. Registered Nurses who plan to take the CRRN exam must meet eligibility requirements. The examination is offered in June and December, via a computerized delivery system.

1. Discuss nursing history, theory, and legislative processes that guide rehabilitation nursing practice.
2. Discuss the role of the rehabilitation nurse in the care and treatment of patients across the continuum of care.
3. Describe disease processes that are commonly seen in the rehabilitation setting.
4. Identify evidenced based nursing interventions for rehabilitation patients and families that will meet individual needs and promote positive patient outcomes.
5. Discuss test taking strategies and tools that can be utilized to prepare for the CRRN exam.
