

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY DRIVER REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Driving Support Group: Free informational sessions are held on the <u>2nd and 4th Tuesdays</u> of the month from <u>1:00-2:00pm</u>, in <u>Outpatient Building Room 1019</u>. Topics include general information about the program, costs, adaptive driving equipment and modified vehicles, DMV information, medical suspensions, special permits, and DMV written and road tests. No appointment or MD referral is needed for this class.

Individual Driver Rehabilitation Sessions: An MD Referral for OT Community Mobility / Driver Rehabilitation must be submitted prior to receiving services. The OT evaluation will be completed first. On-road or simulator driving session can then be scheduled. Please refer to fees below. All on-road driving services utilize the program vehicles with dual gas/brake for our instructor. A <u>valid</u> <u>license or permit</u> is needed to do the Driving Instructor On-Road Evaluation.
